Fresh Sashimi

Tsushima's seafood, including the natural yellowtail and sea bream fish are caught from the warm current of Tsushima strait and are considered to be top class with a sweet taste.



Rokube Noodles

Rokube noodles are made from sweet potatoes. Sweet potato batter dumplings called "sendango" are put into hot water to restore the batter into a ball. Next, the dough is pressed through a noodle press into a bowl of hot water. The noodles are enjoyed with a broth made from seasonal fish.



Taishu Soba Noodles

A popular dish with a simple flavor and essence naturally cultivated in Tsushima.

Iriyaki

A hot pot dish that contains seafood, shiitake mushrooms, and other vegetables cooked in a soup stock.



Ishiyaki (Stone Cooking)

Made with large pieces of fish, abalone, turban shell mollusc and other shellfish, shiitake mushrooms, onions, and other seasonal vegetables. The ingredients are grilled on top of a hot stone. Enjoy the rustic taste of this food with a sauce of your choice.

Wakata Ink Stone Manufacturing Experience

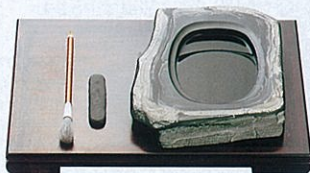

Wakata Inkstones

In Wakata, a part of the Sasu region of Izuhara Town, the raw ore harvested from the Wakata River is refined and shaped into Wakata inkstones, which are the favorite of many calligraphers and used in their masterpieces.



Pearls

Since the time of our ancestors, Tsushima was an island where high grade, natural pearls were harvested. Now, in Aso Bay, pearls are cultivated and then shipped throughout Japan.



Squid

Tsushima's coastal waters are a prominent fishing area for squid. Tsushima's swordtip squid products are among the best in the world.



Tsushima Honey

Tsushima honey, made by the the Japanese honey bee, is collected from the nectar of flowers that bloom year round. This honey is called "the Nectar of 100 Flowers." Because it ages for many years, the honey is very concentrated.



Shiitake Mushrooms

The shiitake that many work hard to cultivate amidst Tsushima's harsh nature are a favorite of souvenir buyers. Enjoy the meat-like thickness, full flavor, and smell of these mushrooms.



Yellowtail

The yellowtail raised within the Tsushima current are said to be the king in terms of rich flavor and are shipped throughout Japan.



Hiougi (Fan) Shellfish

The Hiougi shellfish, raised in the peaceful waves of Tsushima's coves, can be cooked and enjoyed in various ways such as frying or boiling. The vibrant color of the shell is also a merit.



Marine Products

Tsushima's environment is rich with an abundance of minerals. Enjoy the aroma of the island's surroundings.



Kasumaki

One of Tsushima's most famous souvenirs, and similar to castella. This sweet bean roll cake was served 350 years ago when the feudal lords returned to their homes from Edo (modern day Tokyo) to express the joy that the entire household felt.



Sea Urchin

Enjoy the fresh taste of sea urchin just harvested from the sea shore.



Abalone • Turban Shell Mollusc

The abalone and turban shell molluscs cultivated in Tsushima's rough seas have a pleasing texture and taste, and retain the smell of the sea. Enjoy having this rare food delivered to your table.

MODEL COURSE

A Trace the eternal history of Tsushima

Experience the turbulent era in the history of Tsushima when lord Hideyoshi ordered to invade Korea! (3 hour walking course)

Highlights

During the end of the 16th century, Toyotomi Hideyoshi ordered all feudal lords across the nation to send troops to Korea. Until then, Tsushima had a good relationship with Korea through trade and interchange. However, the war caused Tsushima to lose all their trust with Korea. Soh Yoshitoshi, who was the lord of Tsushima domain, worked for years to restore diplomatic relations with Korea. Their efforts were rewarded when they welcomed the envoys of friendship, the Joseon Correspondence Envoys to Japan. This course walks through the former castle town, Izuhara and visits various historical sites.

Highlights

Starting from Izuhara port or Tsushima airport by car, head north driving on route 382. A common sightseeing course including visits at Manzeki bridge and Mt. Eboshi viewpoint.

C Enjoy the extraordinary scenery.

In northern Tsushima, see the night views of the city of Busan Korea across the sea. (2 hour driving course)

Highlights

Tsushima is only 49.5km away from Busan, Korea, and the proximity is palpable when in the northern part of Tsushima. To visit up north, take a taxi, a rental car, or a bus from Izuhara port or Tsushima airport and drive north on route 382 for about two hours. From Hakata, Fukuoka, take the ferry to Hitakatsu port. There are taxis up north as well.
